Weather Spotter Checklist

ITEMS TO HAVE WITH YOU FOR SAFE AND EFFECTIVE SPOTTING

REQUIRED ITEMS

- ∠ County or site Map
- Radio or other communications equipment
- ✓ Identification ARES/ESDA ID, drivers license, vehicle placards

STRONGLY SUGGESTED ITEMS

- Report forms or a micro cassette/digital voice recorder to keep logs with
- Flash light with extra batteries and bulbs

RECOMMENDED

- Binoculars or small telescope
- Rain coat that is bright colored or worn with orange vest

OPTIONAL

- ✓ Video or film camera, with extra tapes, batteries and film
- Fire extinguisher and first aid kit
- ✓ Spare fuses, paper towels, insect repellant

VEHICLE PREPARATION FOR SPOTTING

EVERY TIME YOU GO OUT

- Check your windshield wipers − it's going to rain on you
- ∠ Check your tires tread, pressure, and spare
- ∠ Put a fresh coat of Rain-X on if you have time

AT THE BEGINNING OF STORM SEASON, AND OCCASIONALLY THEREAFTER

- Make sure the lights all work: headlights, flashers, turn signal, brake/backup
- Check your fluid levels: oil, coolant, brake, battery and windshield cleaner
